

The infographic design of the Parthenon comprises a collection of imagery, data, minimal text as well as engaging visuals that conveys an overview of the Parthenon which was built in the 5th century BCE, also known as the Golden age of Pericles. It is well known for its harmonic proportions, precise construction, and lifelike sculptures. A 38 feet tall statue of Athena, the Greek goddess of wisdom and warfare, once stood inside the Parthenon. The Parthenon has a seemingly perfect structure. The Golden Ratio, in which the temple was built, is a ratio between two numbers that equals approximately 1.618. The Doric columns measure 1.9 m in diameter and are 10.4 m high. The Parthenon had 46 outer columns and 23 inner columns. The Parthenon's floor area is measured 73 by 34 m, which is 2484 m².
